On October 3, 2025, as supplemented October 20, 2025, PSEG Long Island (“PSEG LI”), on behalf of and as agent for the Long Island Lighting Company d/b/a LIPA (“LIPA”), filed its Environmental Management and Construction Plan (“EM&CP”) for the Southampton to Deerfield Transmission Project (“Project”) in the above-referenced matter.

Following discussions with DPS Staff, PSEG LI submits this filing to update certain sections of the EM&CP to address feedback received from DPS Staff. Specifically, PSEG LI is updating portions of the EM&CP Narrative (Sections 1, 3, 4 and 6), Appendix A (Plan & Profile Drawings (Sheets F113981 and F114029) and Appendix U (VTMRP Section 5.1), as well as revising Appendices J (MPT) and U (ROW Mgt. Plan). The remaining sections of the EM&CP are unchanged.

Contemporaneously with filing this update, PSEG Long Island will serve either a hard or electronic copy in accordance with Condition 29 of Appendix D of the Joint Proposal approved by the Commission in its “Order Adopting Terms of a Joint Proposal” dated October 17, 2025, and will be post this update on the project web site <https://www.southampton2deerfield.com>
